Our Lenten journey has been very strange these days since we are prevented from gathering at Eucharist to 'remember, celebrate and believe'. We, the Parish of Christ Sun of Justice at the C+CC, are Church and gathering as community, in community, is an essential dimension of who we are as disciples of Jesus.

For many among us the FASTING from gathering as Church is a real hardship. Not only is our routine of the weekend disrupted, but the fruitfulness of that shared time is a real

deprivation. We need each other to fill up what is wanting in us individually.

Many of us pray daily and have a personal relationship with God. For some among us the 'practice of the presence of God' or ongoing conversation with our 'ever-present-companion' Jesus is just part of daily life. But, we are social beings and know that by ourselves we are not whole. We need others, and need *each other*, as faith companions, to live more wholly/holy our relationship with God.


We profess God as Trinity. In the Creed, we name God as Father/Creator, Son/Jesus, the Christ, our brother/Savior, and Holy Spirit/Sanctifier/Fire of Life and Love.

Trinity is *relationship* and Jesus came among us to show us what that looks and feels like. He gathered with his followers and called the many to be in communion. Think of the feeding of the 5000 (Matt. 15:32-39). Jesus knew feeding the Spirit also demanded nurturing the body and sharing a meal. Today we know Liturgy of Word and Eucharist and are fed with both food for soul and body in that great Eucharistic Feast we call Mass. This weekend we would start the culmination of our Lenten days with Palm Sunday's celebrative procession. BUT, there will be no palms in our hands this year! However, hopefully there will still be deep remembrance of Jesus' kingly ride and palms waved by the people of his day.

Holy Thursday will replay Jesus' Last Supper Feast with friends and his giving us the FEAST--Eucharist. Sorrowfully this year, there is no meal together—students, RCIA candidates, families and all. There will be no washing of feet or breaking and eating the Bread of Life and sharing the Wine of Salvation.

On this Good Friday, the agony in the garden and Jesus' passion and death, recounted in the scripture, will not be acted out in our traditional veneration of the cross and stripping the sanctuary of all beauty. We will not be present to each other physically, but hopefully we will be present as Church when in mind, heart and memory we pray with the people of God and the agony of the pandemic that prevails and disrupts this Holy Week. Fasting is our lot; FEASTING is our choice. May Holy Week be richly lived this year as we, members of the Parish of Christ Sun of Justice at the C+CC, together in spirit, do 'remember, celebrate and believe!
