ON 4 JULY 2018, it will be 242 years since the Declaration of Independence was proclaimed in Philadelphia. We remember with gratitude the courage, values, spirituality and commitment of these individuals called our "Founding Fathers". In our age, with all the rhetoric that surrounds us, it would do us well to re-read this document as well as the Constitution and Northwest Ordinances.

With conquering limbs astride from land to land;
Here at our sea-washed, sunset gates shall stand
A mighty woman with a torch, whose flame
Is the imprisoned lightning, and her name
MOTHER OF EXILES. From her beacon-hand
Glows world-wide welcome; her mild eyes command
The air-bridged harbor that twin cities frame.

"Keep, ancient lands, your storied pomp!" cries she
With silent lips. "Give me your tired, your poor,
Your huddled masses yearning to breathe free,
The wretched refuse of your teeming shore.
Send these, the homeless, tempest-tost to me,
I lift my lamp beside the golden door!"

"The New Colossus" is a sonnet that American poet Emma Lazarus (1849-1887) wrote in 1883 to raise money for the construction of a pedestal for the Statue of Liberty. In 1903, the poem was cast onto a bronze plaque and mounted inside the pedestal's lower level. We must wonder what it means today and everyday.....

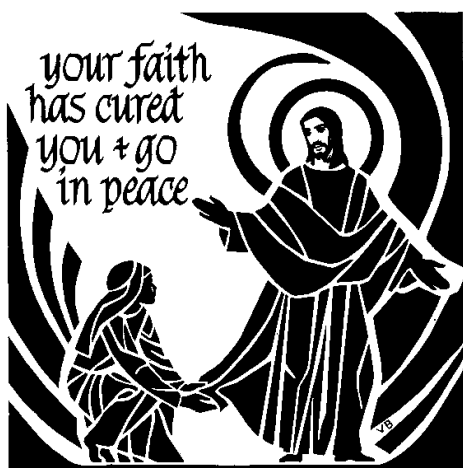
