This year's celebration is being held on 12 and 13 October. Saturday, 12 October, will feature a presentation by Tom Porter of the Kanatsiohare'ke Mohawk Community from 1-3 pm. His talk is entitled "The Journey from Birth to Death: Native American Wisdom on Healing from Trauma." All are welcome, but first responders, hospital/hospice workers, and those dealing with secondary trauma are particularly encouraged to attend. Mass will be held at 4:30 pm Saturday and 10:30 am Sunday, featuring music by the Akwesasne Choir and including Four Directions smudging of sacred plants and a prayer of thanksgiving. We will also be holding our annual burning of prayer petitions after Sunday Mass. Tom Porter (Sakokwenionkas – "The One Who Wins"), a member of the Bear Clan of the Mohawk Nation at Akwesasne, is the founder, director, and spiritual director of the traditional Mohawk Community of Kanatsiohare'ke. Mr. Porter is a champion for the revitalization of native languages and traditions and has devoted his life to implementing programs that facilitate an understanding of Indigenous culture. He has authored several books on Mohawk traditions and spirituality and is a sought-after presenter and speaker.
